[C] But I was lost like a [G] slave that no one could [Am] free [E7]

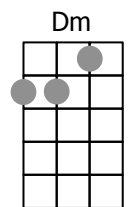


[Am] At break of day when that man drove away I was [E7] waiting

[Am] I felt the knife in my [E7] hand, and she laughed no [Am] more [G7]

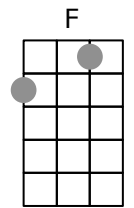
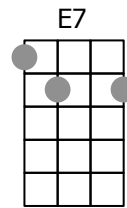
