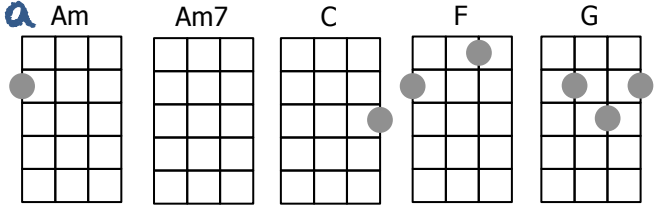


# 21. Letter from America
