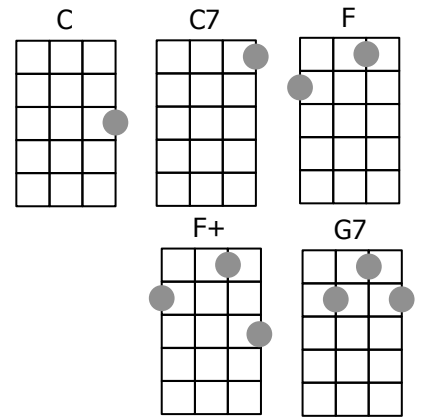


# 34. Frog Went a Courting
