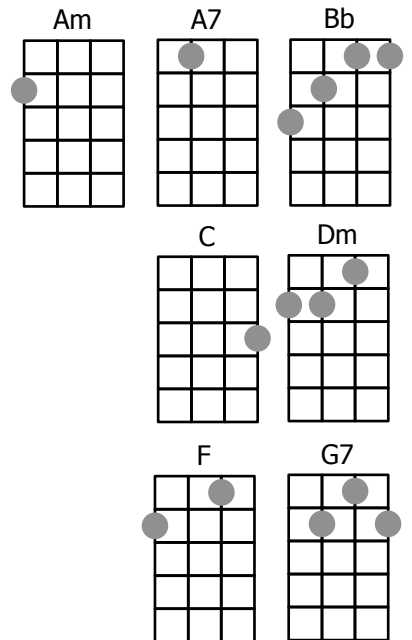


82. Meet me on the corner
