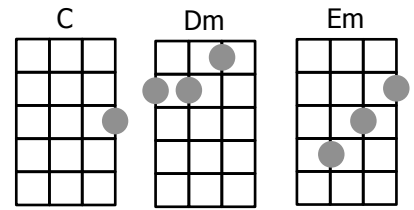


83. I Shall be Released
