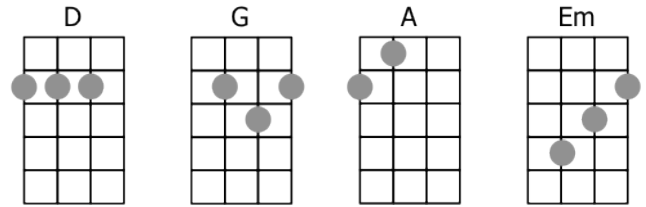

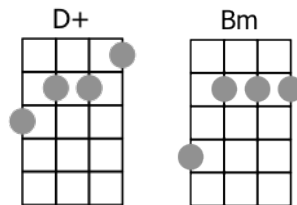
[D] In the Second City of the [G] Emp[A]ire,
