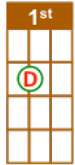


This version uses the chords and melody from Folsom Prison Blues!

1...2...3...4...1...2



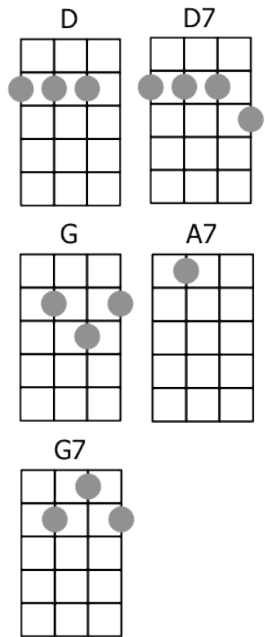
[D]
