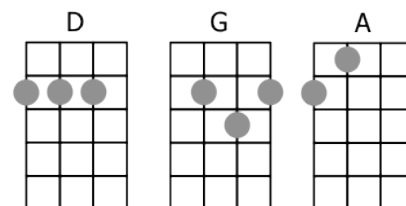


Intro (come in after 3)

 [G] To fall down [A] at your door

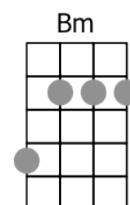
[D] When I'm working, yes, I know I'm gonna be
